

2024 Annual Scholarship Application

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The College Alumnae Club of the NAUW is accepting applications from female African American/Black high school college bound seniors who wish to apply for our \$1,000 scholarship. The deadline to apply is May 10, 2024 at 5 p.m. EDT. Scholarship awardees will be notified by June 14, 2024. The scholarship funds will be disbursed to the students' college, university, or higher education institute account.

GUIDELINES/CRITERIA

The applicant must:

- Be African American/Black female.
- Be a resident of the following jurisdictions in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan area: Washington, DC; Prince George's County, MD; Montgomery County, MD; City of Alexandria, VA; or Arlington County, VA
- Attend an accredited public high school in the following jurisdictions in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan area: Washington, DC; Prince George's County, MD; Montgomery County, MD; City of Alexandria, VA; or Arlington County, VA
- Be in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 GPA (i.e., 77-79% or C+).
- Be a High School Senior accepted at an accredited 4-year or accredited 2-year academic institution of higher education in a program leading to an academic degree, diploma, or certificate of higher study.
- Have good leadership skills as evidenced by a strong community service record.
- Have participated in extracurricular activities.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST – Your application will be considered complete upon receipt of the following items:

- A completed and signed application
- A copy of ACT or SAT scores unless waived
- An official high school transcript
- A copy of your college/university acceptance letter
- A copy of your decision letter/note indicating your college/university choice
- A personal essay (not to exceed 500 words, double spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font) addressing the following questions:
 - What are your career goals/aspirations?
 - o Which community service activity has affected you more personally and why?
 - How will community service be integrated into your future career goals?
- Two reference letters
 - One letter must be from an educational professional (such as a teacher or counselor).
 - The other letter may be from another source (such as a coach or mentor).
 - References should not be relatives.
 - Refer to the Reference Guidelines Form in the application packet on page 5.
